WHAT'S ON IN THIS PARISH...

- **Annual Church Meetings, TODAY Sunday 26th April.** We ask God's blessing on our annual meetings when we elect Churchwardens and representatives of the laity to the Deanery Synod, the Cross Hills & District Fellowship of Church Council and the PCC. Please take a copy of the Annual Report booklet and the Accounts if you haven't already done so.
- **Church Electoral Roll.** Names may be added to the church electoral roll as from the end of the Annual Meetings. The Electoral Roll Officer is Christine Anderton.
- Easter Service of Commemoration and Thanksgiving for Departed Family and Friends, 6.00pm NEXT Sunday 3rd May. Invitations cards are available for you to take and pass on to someone who might wish to come.
- **Tour de Yorkshire passing through Cross Hills and Kildwick, NEXT Sunday 3rd May.** We will begin our summer season with Tea & Scones served from 2.00pm in the Parish Rooms and on the church green; the church will also be open to visitors. We will need more people than usual to help; please sign the list.

We have received the Chancellor's Judgement and he has approved all parts of the proposed reordering scheme except the removal of the 8 rows of pews at the east end of the south aisle. We have asked our architect to prepare the tender document in order to seek quotes for the work.
