WHAT'S ON ELSEWHERE...

Paul Slater to be Bishop of Richmond. The Venerable Paul Slater, currently the Archdeacon of Richmond and Craven, has been appointed as Bishop of Richmond – a new suffragan bishop post for the Diocese of West Yorkshire & the Dales, and the first Bishop of Richmond in nearly 100 years. The See of Richmond has been dormant since 1921 but has been revived, adding a sixth bishop to the diocesan leadership team. Paul will mainly cover the Bishop of Leeds' work in the Leeds Episcopal Area, working with clergy and parishes, and will occasionally deputise for Bishop Nick, who will remain Area Bishop of Leeds. Paul will be consecrated bishop in Ripon Cathedral TODAY.
