- **Receiving Communion during the winter.** If you are suffering from a cough or a cold please consider intincting (dipping) your wafer in the wine, instead of receiving the wine directly from the chalice. This will minimise the risk of sharing any bugs. To intinct, simply dip the edge of the wafer briefly into the wine taking care not to put your fingertips into the wine.

- **Pilgrim course, 'The Commandments', w/c 4th January.** The third module of the *Pilgrim* course will explore the Commandments and will take place over 6 weeks.
