## WHAT'S ON IN THIS PARISH...

**Ascension Day to the Day of Pentecost.** Since the late fourth century there has been a particular celebration of Christ's Ascension. He commissions his disciples to continue his work, he promises the gift of the Holy Spirit, and then he is no longer among them in the flesh. The Ascension is therefore closely connected with the theme of mission. The days between Ascension Day and the Day of Pentecost are days of prayer for the coming of the Holy Spirit. The arrival of the promised gift of the Holy Spirit on the day of Pentecost will complete and crown the Easter Festival.
