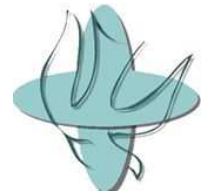
Visit by Michael Hardin of Preaching Peace, 21st - 25th September. Michael is making a welcome return to Kildwick and will be leading the following seminars:
