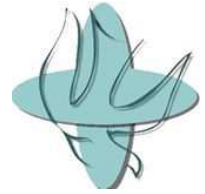
Visit by Michael Hardin of Preaching Peace, NEXT week 21st - 25th September. Michael will be leading the following seminars:
