Bradford Episcopal Area Deanery Reorganisation. With effect from 1st January there will be a change in the organisation of the deaneries in our Episcopal Area. There will be 4 deaneries, namely: South Craven & Wharfedale, Aire & Worth, Outer Bradford, Inner Bradford. We will be in the Deanery of South Craven & Wharfedale together with the parishes of Silsden, Sutton-in-Craven, Cowling, Lothersdale, Cononley with Bradley, Addingham, Ilkley All Saints, Ilkley St Margaret, Ben Rhydding, Burley-in-Wharfedale, and Menston with Woodhead. Our Area Dean will be the Revd Canon Philip Gray, Vicar of St Margaret's, Ilkley.

Receiving Communion during the winter. If you are suffering from a cough or a cold please consider intincting (dipping) your wafer in the wine, instead of receiving the wine directly from the chalice. This will minimise the risk of sharing any bugs. To intinct, simply dip the edge of the wafer briefly into the wine taking care not to put your fingertips into the wine.
