WHAT'S ON IN THIS PARISH...

- **Lent Collection for WaterAid.** Please bring your box back by NEXT Sunday 10^h April. If you can gift aid your collection please attach a yellow gift aid envelope to the box (having filled in the details and signed).
- **Pilgrim course, 'The Beatitudes', w/c 4th April.** The next module of the *Pilgrim* course will explore the Beatitudes and will take place over 6 weeks. Each module stands alone so there is no requirement to have attended previous modules to attend this one. A group will meet at 1.30pm on Mondays and a group will meet at 7.30pm on Wednesdays. - 'Temple Themes in Christian Worship' Seminar with Margaret Barker, Saturday 16th April.
