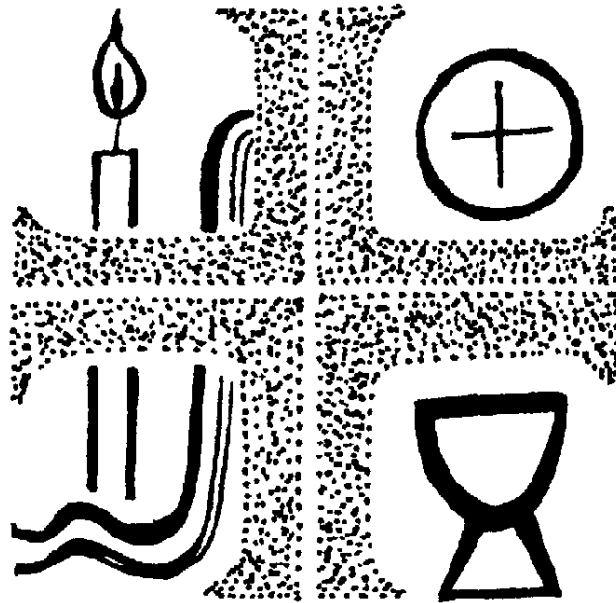
## WHAT'S ON ELSEWHERE...
