#### WHAT'S ON IN THIS PARISH...

- **Holy Week.** Volunteers are still needed to be Welcomers and Lesson Readers during Holy Week. Please look at the list in church and sign where you can help.
- All are encouraged to attend as many of the Holy Week services as possible, especially Maundy Thursday, Good Friday and Easter Eve. The services on these days will take place in the chancel at the east end of the church.
- **Decorating the church for Easter.** This will take place NEXT Saturday morning. If you are unable to come please give some spring flowers. Contact June Whitaker, 655320, for more details.
- **Donations for Easter Lilies.** If you would like to make a donation towards the cost of our Easter lilies please place it in the basket in church. Also, if you can help with decorating the church on Easter Eve please contact June Whitaker, 655320.
- **Easter Day 10am service, NEXT Sunday.** As we come to celebrate the Resurrection together we will be using the nave altar, with the Easter Cross to be flowered standing in our nave sanctuary space. Please bring some flowers with you to put on the Easter Cross.
- **Lent Collection for the Church of Sudan.** Please bring your box back on Easter Day or any time until Sunday 7<sup>th</sup> May. If you can gift aid your collection please attach a yellow gift aid envelope to the box (having filled in the details).
- **Annual Revision of the Electoral Roll.** If you are not yet on the electoral roll but wish to be so you must apply by TODAY Sunday 9<sup>th</sup> April. Forms are available in church or from Christine Anderton, 6 Airedale View, Cross Hills. A copy of the present roll is available for checking.

#### WHAT'S ON ELSEWHERE...

**Easter Day Sunrise Service, 6.00am NEXT Sunday at Farnhill Pinnacle.** The service will be followed by refreshments in Kildwick & Farnhill Institute.

Hosting Project (https://beaconbradford.org/projects/hosting/), over the past eight years a number of local volunteer households have provided a spare room, meals and kindness to more than sixty 'refused' asylum seekers who would otherwise have been homeless. With help and support, many of these have gone on to submit successful fresh asylum claims and are now settled and working in the UK. One recently married an Anglican vicar! Without this help, many would have been forced into very dangerous and exploitative lifestyles; some would have been forced to return to the lands they had fled and possible death or imprisonment. However the project urgently needs more households able to host single men.
