WHAT'S ON IN THIS PARISH...

- **An Easter thank you** to everyone who has been involved in the planning, preparation and leading of the services during Holy Week and Easter. Thank you to everyone who has helped to decorate the church in celebration of this great festival.
- **Lent Collection for the Church of Sudan.** Please bring your box back on Easter Day or any time until Sunday 7th May. If you can gift aid your collection please attach a yellow gift aid envelope to the box (having filled in the details).
- **Celebration of April birthdays and prayers for healing.** These will be included in the 10.00am service NEXT Sunday 23rd April.
- **Annual Revision of the Electoral Roll.** A copy of the revised roll is on display in the church porch. No new names may be added to the Roll until after the annual meetings on Sunday 30th April.
- **Annual Meetings, Sunday 30th April.** There will be the following elections: 2 x Churchwardens to serve for one year; 2 x Deanery Synod representatives to serve until June 2020; 3 x PCC representatives to serve until 2020, 1 x PCC representative to serve until 2019; 2 x CDFC Council representatives to serve until June 2018.
