WHAT'S ON IN THIS PARISH...

Ascension Day to the Day of Pentecost. Since the late fourth century there has been a particular celebration of Christ's Ascension. He commissions his disciples to continue his work, he promises the gift of the Holy Spirit, and then he is no longer among them in the flesh. The Ascension is therefore closely connected with the theme of mission. The days between Ascension Day and the Day of Pentecost are days of prayer for the coming of the Holy Spirit. The arrival of the promised gift of the Holy Spirit on the day of Pentecost will complete and crown the Easter Festival.

Reflective bible reading during 10am services Sundays 14th, 21st & 28th May.

On these 3 Sundays we will gather in small groups in the open space at the front of the nave for the Liturgy of the Word, during which we will share in a reflective reading of the gospel for the day. We will then move to the chancel for the Liturgy of the Sacrament. See pages 4-5 of the magazine for more details.
