News from the Vicarage. Robin concludes his ministry as Vicar of Kildwick in 2 weeks on Sunday 23rd July and the Figg family will leave the Vicarage the following week. Robin's Institution & Induction as Vicar of Warton and Borwick with Yealand in the Diocese of Blackburn will take place on Monday 4th September at 7.30pm at St Oswald's Church, Warton.
